- in case of cancellation of the dog before the closing date WITHOUT cancellation fee (paid entry fee will be refunded)
- in case of cancellation after the deadline or non-attendance 100% cancellation (the paid entry fee will NOT be refunded)
- 1 solo license run 450 CZK / 21 EUR
- 1 pair license run 600 CZK / 28 EUR

Admission:

marked area next to the restaurant 7:00 - 8:15 AM - start of the coursing 8:30 AM - finish approx. 5:00 PM (according to weather conditions - subject to change)

Veterinary regulations:

- All competing dogs must be accompanied by a valid pet passport, vaccination certificate or other document containing the records of a private veterinarian for the required vaccinations or other health records.
- Dogs must be clinically healthy, in good condition and come from a place free of dangerous diseases transmissible to carnivores.
- Dogs must be immune to rabies.
- Every dog (participating in the event) must pass a veterinary examination. Anyone who fails to arrive at the specified time will not be admitted to the event.
- Chip numbers will be checked, please make sure the chip is active to avoid irregularities.
- Dogs younger than 2 years and older than 6 years must pass a veterinary examination before the second round, otherwise they will not be allowed to start in the second round.
- A vet will be present throughout the race.

Mandatory dog equipment:

- Appropriate coloured blanket without advertisements, numbers and other accessories, racing muzzle, also valid for PLI in accordance with the FCI Regulations for International sighthound racing and lure coursing events.
- The muzzle must not be in the colours of the national flag, garish or neon colours
- Only dogs wearing complete mandatory equipment will be allowed to come to the START of the course!!!
 - The complete mandatory equipment must be worn until the dog leaves the field!

Doping:

- All types of doping are forbidden!!! Par. 1. 10 Doping, see FCI Regulations for International sighthound racing and lure coursing events.

Prizes:

- for 1st 6th place
- Best Male and Female in Field prizes of honour

Course:

- the dogs will be placed in the 1st round runs by Dog-go draw, the schedule of coursing runs will be posted before the start of the 1st round and is final, the run composition cannot be changed
- the track is moderately demanding
- motor lure machine, lure pulled over pulleys
- length 600-900 metres
- no unauthorized persons allowed on the course track!

Start and paddock:

- the participant must be ready in front of the paddock two runs in advance, then he will be asked to enter the paddock
- only dogs wearing complete mandatory equipment will be allowed to come to the start
 of the course!!! The complete mandatory equipment must be worn until the dog
 leaves the field!

Disclaimer:


- neither the organizer nor the officials are responsible for injuries caused by dog owners, dogs or officials themselves. Likewise, they accept no responsibility in case of escaped dogs. The owner is not responsible for injuries caused by his dog during coursing. In all other cases the dog owner has the full responsibility for the dog.
- it is STRICTLY PROHIBITED to let dogs run loose.
- if a dog not participating in the individual course runs to the field, the owner of the dog will pay a fine of 500 CZK and will be liable for the damages caused by the case.
- the organizer reserves the right to cancel the competition, part of the entry fee will be used to cover the costs according to the situation.
- it is necessary to observe the current valid hygiene measures on the day of the event!


Disputes:

- no appeal can be made against a decision of the jury (scoring, DISQ, etc.). A protest can be filed only for technical reasons such as an unauthorized start of a dog (start of a female in heat, invalid license card, etc.), after depositing a deposit of 500 CZK, which is forfeited to the organizer if the protest is unjustified. Otherwise, it is returned to the proposer. If this procedure is not followed, the objections will not be taken into account.

Parking:

- ALL participants are obliged to follow the instructions of the organizers
- FREE parking
- it is possible to park along the whole fence of the restaurant the parking lot in front of the restaurant is for guests





Everyone who submits an entry acknowledges the provisions of this coursing announcement, acknowledges the veterinary regulations according to the announcement, undertakes to follow the instructions of the organizers, is obliged to observe the International and National Racing and Coursing Regulations and confirm that does not have a dog under the influence of doping substances.

CLUB WINNER OF BEAUTY AND PERFORMANCE OF KYNOLOGICKÁ JEDNOTA ČR

The condition for obtaining the title Club Winner of Beauty and Performance KJ CR 2025 is to participate in the All Breeds Regional Dog Show on September 28, 2025 in Bílý Kostel nad Nisou and compete at the Autumn Cup Coursing in Vysoká on October 4-5, 2025.

The title Club Winner of Beauty and Performance KJ CR 202 goes to the male and female with the highest sum of points from the coursing and the show. Points from coursing can be gained in any category according to the valid regulations. Points at the show can be gained in junior, intermediate, open, working, winner, honorary and veteran class. Dogs without registered FCI pedigree cannot get the title.

In case of equality of points, the title goes to the individual with the higher number of points from coursing.
